Dear Friends,

Greetings to you in this season when we celebrate the incarnation of God's Son. This past Sunday our church family shared a meal after the worship service and decorated the church for Christmas. We are rejoicing during this season, singing Christmas carols and finishing the final weeks of our Christmas series on Sunday morning. We are studying how the accounts of the birth of John the Baptist and the incarnation of Christ are interwoven in the Scripture. In junior church we usually have five to seven children attend, all of them from the tribe. Nancy has been teaching in Cheryl's absence, and has been exploring the different characters in the Christmas story. She knows many of the children from her work at the public school, so she already has built a relationship with them. The mission pantry has been busy. We had about twenty families last Wednesday. Our church pantry will be on December 15th. We moved the pantry from Wednesday to Saturday and the hours will be from 1 to 3pm. We are hoping this will bring more people out. In January we have Parry and Angeline Stelter coming to speak. They are from Word of Hope Ministries and they will be giving a seminar on the Biblical response to grief, loss and trauma. It will be held at our church on Thursday, January 24th at 7pm. Since grief, loss, and trauma are so prevalent in the native community we ask your prayers that many would come out, and that there would be a great impact. We also ask for your prayers for several members of our congregation. B. is suffering with cancer, congestive heart failure, and kidney failure. Another member is recovering from major surgery. We also ask your prayers for Cheryl's progress as she recovers from foot surgery. We thank all of you for your prayer and support and wish you a merry Christmas and blessed New Year.
